Through our topic we have been exploring different materials and finding out what properties they have. Next week we are going on a different adventure and flying to China to celebrate the key event: Chinese New Year. Year 2

In our topic learning this week, we have used atlases to locate and name the seven continents of the world, along with the five oceans of the world. We have also explored the names of our major cities within our Country and used atlases to find their locations. We cannot wait to use these skills to write our own instructions for Year R 1 about how we made our very own balloons!
