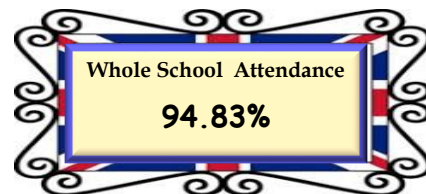

For sharing super science knowledge in our topic work.

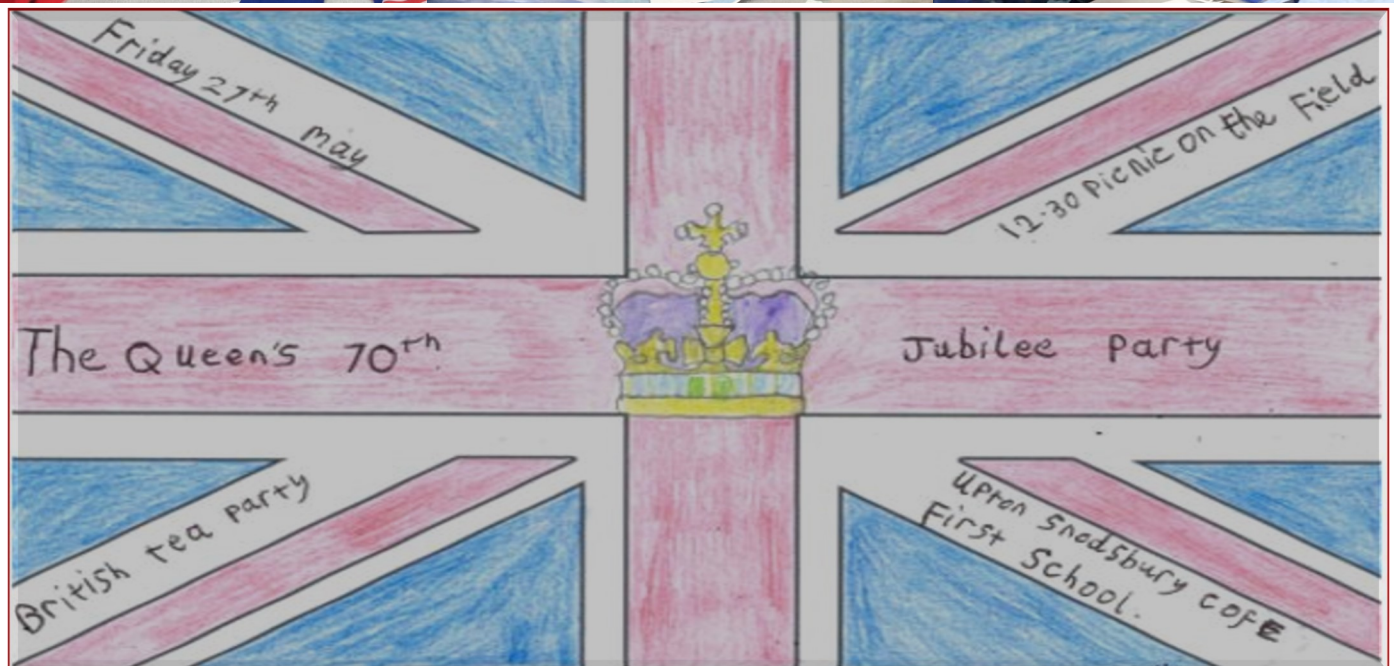
